

Theale Green Uniform Regulations (end Sept 2012)

These regulations apply to students in years 8 to 11 during the school year 2011/12. A new uniform list applies to year 7. Students in years 8 to 11 may buy items from the new uniform list during this year. Only new uniform items are available from our stockists, Jacksons and Meadway Outfitters.

Our school uniform is:

- Plain black tailored trousers for boys and girls OR plain black knee length skirt for girls
- School blazer worn with white shirt and school tie (boys and girls)
- OR Black school jumper worn with white shirt and school tie, white blouse (girls only) or school polo shirt
- A plain coat or jacket: no simulated or real leather, battle dress or denim; no logos, pictures or lettering; no hooded sweatshirts.
- Black school shoes: no trainers, high heels, canvas shoes, open toes or sandals.
- Grey, white or black socks; plain, neutral or black tights: no patterned or footless tights

During the summer term only, the polo shirt may be worn without the blazer or jumper.

The school blazer, jumper and polo shirt can only be bought from the official suppliers.

Jewellery.....

You may wear a watch and one plain stud earring in each ear. No other jewellery is allowed and students will be required to remove any body piercing. Jewellery will be confiscated and only returned with a commitment from parents that it will not be worn again. High fashion belts should not be worn.

Sixth Form Dress Code.....

Sixth Form dress code is "smart casual". However students are required to dress modestly; crop tops, short skirts, shorts, ripped jeans, jogging bottoms and low necklines are not acceptable. There should be no visible body piercing.

Valuable items.....

You are discouraged from bringing any valuable items to school, as their safety cannot be guaranteed. Any valuable items such as mobile phones and personal stereos are entirely the responsibility of the owner and the school accepts no liability for loss or damage to any item. Mobile phones and personal stereos should not be used in lessons and will be confiscated if this happens. A letter from parents is required for their return.

Please make sure all personal belongings, including mobile phones, are clearly marked with your name.

NOTE: The school uniform and dress regulations will be **strictly enforced**.
