



Sixth Form Dress Code – September 2011 onwards

The dress code for the Theale Green Sixth Form is smart casual. The Sixth Form at Theale Green Community School enjoy a more relaxed dress code than younger years. However, there is an expectation that students dress appropriately for school. It must be recognised that school is a place of work which younger students attend.

Further guidance regarding appropriate dress is as follows:

- Smart denim jeans are allowed, but should not be ripped
- Trousers should be full length. Shorts and three quarter lengths are not permitted.
- Tracksuit trousers or jogging bottoms are not permitted unless worn during specific PE lessons or school sporting activities.
- Words and diagram on clothing should not be offensive or possibly seen as offensive (e.g. references to drugs or sex)
- Footwear should be appropriate for the lesson. Open shoes are not suitable for practical subjects and flip-flops are a health and safety concern in the busy areas of the school
- Modesty is expected – shoulders and midriffs should be covered (i.e. no strappy tops or vests)
Skirts should be of a reasonable length
- Facial piercings should be discreet (clear plastic)
